# FIRST SESSION:

- 1. Presentation: Read and understand the new concepts and words.
- 2. Practice: Identify new concepts and words through pictures.
- 3. Classify pictures of landscapes and identify landforms by labeling the given pictures with the new concepts and words.
- 4. Homework: finish it at home.

## **SECOND SESSION:**

- 1. Listen and identify landscapes and landforms.
- 2. Present your landscape to the whole group orally.
- 3. Make the landscape poster: Paste your landscapes together to complete the poster.
- 4. Homework: Reading worksheet on "Different kind of terrain" BurlingtonBooks.

**<u>FINAL TASK</u>**: Writing and talking about your favorite type of landscape and evaluating our project.

### **THIRD SESSION:**

- 1. Work and correct homework
- 2. Card game in pair/group work: Match definitions to landforms.
- 3. Homework: Landscape adjectives sheet and writing plan: They have to write a composition about their favorite landscape, illustrate it and also prepare a talk.

### FOURTH SESSION:

- 4. Ask and answer questions about landscapes in groups of four: One pupil chooses a picture from a calendar, the others make questions taken form a block of questions and imagine what the landscape is like. Then they change roles in the group.
- 5. Homework: Prepare the oral and written presentation of your project on your favorite landscape.

### FIFTH SESSION:

- 1. Drawing dictation: The teacher dictates about a landscape and students draw a picture.
- 2. Students present their favorite landscape while the others fill in a worksheet, as a listening exercise and they also co-evaluate their classmates work.
- 3. Showing pictures on landscapes as a review on our first Earth Science lesson.
- 4. Homework: Review for content assessment and self-assessment.

### **SIXTH SESSION:**

1. Students present their favorite landscape while the others fill in a worksheet, as a listening exercise and they also co-evaluate their classmates work.

### SEVENTH SESSION

- 1. Teachers show a ppt presentation and students fill in an evaluation sheet, working in groups
- 2. Homework: Self-assessment worksheet.
