

beach	Stones and sand by the sea.
cliff	A high piece of land with a steep side.
cove	A small bay.
crater	Mouth of a volcano
dune	Low extension of loose, dry sand formed by the wind, especially near the sea shore.
glacier	Mass of ice formed by snow on mountains.

gulf

Part of the sea almost surrounded by land, e.g., Gulf of Mexico.

gully

Narrow channel cut or formed by rainwater.

island

An area of land surrounded by the sea.

lake

A large area of water surrounded by land.

lava

Hot liquid material flowing from a volcano.

mountain
range

Series of mountains more or less in a line.

plain

An area of level land.

plateau

A wide level land high above the sea-level.

ravine

Deep, narrow valley.

spring

Place where there is water coming up from the ground.

valley

A low area, usually between mountains, often with a river.

waterfall

Cascade of falling water where there is a vertical step in a river.
